Official Plan Amendment: Hespeler Road Corridor Secondary Plan

Description: The purpose and effect of the Hespeler Road Corridor Secondary Plan is to provide a planning framework to guide future development and redevelopment in the Hespeler Road Corridor area. The Plan area includes three Protected Major Transit Station Areas (PMTSA). The Official Plan Amendment delineates the boundaries of the PMTSAs, sets minimum density targets, and establishes land use designations to support the achievement of a transit-supportive built form.
